

HOW DO I GET ASSESSED?

A doctor's referral is required for clients to be seen for an assessment (even if the MTO is requesting the assessment). Referral forms are available through our office and website.



ABOUT OUR PROGRAM and STAFF

We review and monitor all referrals, follow up with both physicians and clients to ensure all referrals have been properly processed and contact the referring source when we are unable to proceed with an assessment.

We strongly encourage family involvement in the pre and post-assessment process.

Our driving program staff includes registered **Occupational Therapists** with **experience** and training in driving assessment and rehabilitation.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Driving is an important and meaningful activity of daily living. The ability to drive safely can be impacted by disease, trauma or aging.

Any individual who has a medical condition which may affect his/her ability to drive is eligible for a driving assessment. The client's licence may be valid or suspended. If the client's licence is suspended, we will apply to the MTO for a one day temporary licence for the purpose of driving assessment. Depending on the circumstances, the assessment may or may not be an MTO requirement. The program is open to both experienced and novice drivers.

Adaptive Driving Equipment

Our services include assessment, training and prescription for vehicle modifications. If the client may require the use of a modified vehicle, please notify us at the time of referral.

DRIVING REHABILITATION THERAPY SERVICES

1. **Full Driving Assessment** includes:

- In-office assessment
- On-road assessment
- Discussion of results

Possible results include:

- Functional Driving Skills (pass)
- Driving Rehabilitation Candidate
- Driving Cessation Recommended

2. If Driving Rehabilitation is recommended, then the client is eligible to participate in **rehabilitation driving lessons**. Client would be taught functional driving skills and compensatory strategies.

3. If the Client participates in lessons, and lessons are successful, the client would then be eligible for a reassessment. **Reassessment** includes on-road assessment and discussion of results.

FEE SCHEDULE

Full driving assessment (in office and on-road) \$ 550.00

On Road Reassessment \$ 345.00

Cancellation fee (If client does not give 24hrs notice) \$75.00

Included in the assessment fee is a report which is sent to the client, the doctor, and if applicable, the MTO.

Additional fees apply if the client requests other forms or reports such as for funding application.

Fees for rehabilitation driving lessons are set by and paid directly to the driving instructor who is partnered with this program.
